We also defend clients against claims that a hazardous substance caused damage to water, land or air and in state or federal government regulatory/clean-up actions and brownfields claims. These complex cases can demand money or remediation to bring the water, land or air back to the state it was in before the alleged exposure. These suits might be brought as toxic tort cases or as premises, product or general liability matters.

Our lawyers keep clients fully informed and involved during the fact-finding and decision-making stages of these high risk cases, including those that often involve alleged product defects, occupational and consumer exposure to heavy metals, inks, solvents, silica and sick buildings or near storage tanks.
