David Greene Serving on Bench Bar Committee

Greene, Co-Chair of Weber Gallagher's Workers' Compensation Group, is also author of several chapters of the *Pennsylvania Bar Institute Pennsylvania Workers' Compensation Practice & Procedure* manual that is considered the "Bible" on workers' compensation law in Pennsylvania.
